COVID-19 Vaccine Update: January 7, 2021

Martin County is supporting the Florida Department of Health's efforts to distribute the COVID-19 vaccine to our residents. The Florida Department of Health (FDOH) in Martin County is the lead agency on vaccine distribution in our area. Vaccines are being distributed by the state to the Florida Department of Health in Martin County and Cleveland Clinic Martin Health. Martin County is working with our partners and committed to making this information from the state available to our residents.

As of Thursday, January 7, we have the following information to share:

- The Florida Department of Health in Martin County has received 2,800 vaccine doses, which have been allocated to priority groups, including frontline health care workers/first responders and individuals 65 and older, as outlined in Governor Ron DeSantis' Executive Order 20-315.
- Demand for the vaccine is very high across the state and the supply is limited. The Florida
 Department of Health in Martin County is experiencing very high call volume and web traffic and is
 urging residents to have patience as they navigate this process.
- The Florida Department of Health in Martin County is offering drive thru vaccination clinics, however, all appointments for available vaccine doses are fully booked at this time. FDOH will announce via their website at www.MartinCountyHealth.com and Twitter @GoHealthyMartin when additional vaccines are received and appointment scheduling resumes. Local media will continue to share updates related to vaccinations.
- At this time, Cleveland Clinic Martin Health has allocated their vaccine supply and suspended scheduling eligible patients. Scheduling will resume as soon as additional vaccines are received. Continue to monitor my.clevelandclinic.org/landing/covid-19-vaccine/florida for updates.
- Please contact your primary care provider directly for more information about vaccination plans.
- Martin County is partnering with our 55+ communities in an effort to facilitate the most efficient means to vaccinate our 65 and older community per Executive Order 20-315.
- Governor Ron DeSantis has announced that certain Publix pharmacies across the state will begin vaccinating patrons, but this plan does not include any stores in Martin County at this time.
